Significant Humanitarian Facts



During the genocidal war, 12,125 lost their husbands, while 3,500 children are currently at risk of death due to malnutrition and food scarcity. Additionally, there have been 2,136,026 reported cases of infectious diseases stemming from displacement. The World Health Organization has documented 1,210,306 instances of acute respiratory infections, 574,813 cases of acute watery diarrhea, and 114,367 occurrences of acute jaundice syndrome. (4)



The restricted entry of shelter materials into the Gaza Strip has resulted in assistance being provided to only 285,000 individuals from September to late November 2024. Meanwhile, at least 945,000 others are in urgent need of winter support to safeguard them against rain and severe weather conditions. (4)



The interruption of food aid in the Gaza Strip has caused a significant reduction in food accessibility, with the number of households experiencing poor or severe food consumption tripling, and the number of households facing food shortages doubling since July. (5)

Risks threatening Gaza Strip



A monitoring survey conducted by UNICEF from November 26 to December 6 revealed that almost all children aged 6 to 23 months, as well as pregnant and lactating women in Gaza City, Deir al-Balah, and Khan Younis, fail to achieve the minimum standards of dietary diversity. (4) (3)



Currently, only four out of the 19 bakeries supported by the World Food Programme are operational within the Gaza Strip, and all of these are located in the Gaza governorate. (3) (4)



Human Rights Watch has indicated that the Israeli authorities have intentionally imposed living conditions on the Palestinian population in Gaza that are aimed at undermining a portion of the population by systematically denying adequate access to water for Palestinian civilians.
